POSTDOCTORAL POSITIONS

at the Faculty of Chemistry

in the area of chemistry (financed by KNOW funds)

The competition is open to applicants who meet the requirements of Art. 109 of the Act of 27.07.2005, the Law on Higher Education (Dz. U. nr 164, poz. 1365), and satisfy the following qualification criteria:

- have a PhD degree in chemistry or a related discipline
- have documented scientific achievements
- active participation in international scientific conferences, academic life, and involvement in research projects
- provide reference letters of two independent researchers about ability of the candidate to research work

The Candidates must submit at the Faculty of Chemistry, 30-060 Krakow, ul. Ingardena 3, room 15 the following documents

- 1) Application letter along with the completed application form
- 2) Curriculum Vitae
- 3) A copy of PhD diploma,
- 4) Personal questionnaire
- 5) select at most two research projects to work on from the list available at <http://www.chemia.uj.edu.pl/wydzial/know/tematy-badawcze>, indicating the preferred one
- 6) a list of publications (indicating the five most important, providing the publisher, number of pages and the impact factor), and h-index
- 7) reference letters of two independent researchers about ability of the candidate to research work
- 8) a statement that the Jagiellonian University will be the primary work place in case of winning the competition
- 9) a declaration required by the Act of 27.07.2005 of the Law on Higher Education
- 10) a statement on acceptance of the rules of intellectual property and the legal protection of intellectual properties.

Items 5 and 6 must be submitted on the application form


Application deadline expires on 13 September 2016

Candidates who apply for the competition and submit the full documentation in due time may be invited for presentation of their candidature

The competition will be resolved on the basis of rules of the KNOW internships until 23 September 2016
Successful candidates will be employed as a research associate for one year from 1 October 2016
